Although the beginning of John's Gospel is usually associated with the feast of Christmas and the mystery of Incarnation--the Word becoming flesh--it also expresses the culmination of that mystery in the bodily Resurrection of Jesus. John, writing in hindsight, with the benefit of several decades of reflection following the actual events of Jesus' Passion, Crucifixion, and Resurrection, poetically expresses the timeless power of God throughout all of salvation history, even through our own times of distress, confusion, pain, and death:

*In the beginning was the Word;
and the Word was with God
and the Word was God.
He was with God in the beginning.
Through him all things came to be,
not one thing had its being but through him.
All that came to be had life in him
and that life was the light of men,
a light that shines in the dark,
a light that darkness could not overpower...
The Word was made flesh,
he lived among us,
and we saw his glory,
the glory that is his as the only
Son of the Father,
full of grace and truth.*

All are welcome to assist with the laying on of the hands as our parishioners are being Anointed.
