❖ These parables are told in response to the criticism of Jesus for "hanging out" with the "riff raff," those known to be public sinners and on the fringe of the respectable people. Jesus simply saw them as children of his Heavenly Father. Jesus simply wanted to love and respect them and so empower them to be their best selves.

❖ The story of the Prodigal Son is the great climax of these "lost and found parables." The one who is really "prodigal" or lavish is the Father! His love knows no bounds. His heart aches for the son he lost. His heart aches for the son who never left but whose hardened heart was far from his own.

❖ I must confess to you that a few times in the past when I proclaimed this gospel during Mass, I became so overwhelmed by the depth of love and acceptance of the all-forgiving father, that I could barely complete reading the gospel.
