• Do you like the message on the outdoor church sign? *Freedom isn't free. We pay the price, We sacrifice for our liberty! Happy July 4 th!* If you are of my "era" you may have noticed echoes of an "Up With People" song! When they were popular in the 60's I was so taken with them that I wanted to run off with them and spread good will around the world! My choices were, St. Lawrence Seminary, or Up with People! I don't think Mom would have approved the Up with People choice. She also did not want me to go away to high school! I was a good "momma's helper" with my four younger brothers.



• Thank God for Dad! He intervened and said if I wanted to go to the seminary that badly, they should let me go! And of course the rest is history.

• I digress! Freedom. Nightly we witness the great sacrifices our brave women and men make around the world in defense of freedom. We remember them in prayer in a special way this weekend, that they may return home safe and sound to their loved ones.

• A portion of Psalm 122 has been meaningful to me for many years. I find myself praying it daily. *Pray for the Peace (Shalom) of Jerusalem. May those who love you prosper. May peace be within your walls, prosperity in your buildings. Because of my relatives and friends, I will pray for your good.*

• I find several layers of meaning in this Psalm. The most obvious one is peace in the Middle East among Jews, Arabs, Muslims, Christians. I include all the world's hot spots in this prayer.

• Another layer of meaning is in the word "Shalom." This "peace" is much more than the absence of war. Shalom is present when we are in right relationship with ourselves, with our neighbors, with all of creation, with our God. I long for that depth of freedom when respect is so rooted in every dimension of creation that all violence is gone, once and for ALL.

• And a third level for me is "because of my relatives and friends...." This is my way of remembering daily, my brothers and their families, my friends and acquaintances, and all the people of St. James Parish. Join me in this prayer as we celebrate the enduring gift of FREEDOM.

• Another digression! I celebrated my First Mass July 4, 1982. We had a great time decked out in red, white and blue, and celebrating at the "Blue Canary"

on the south side of Milwaukee!

• By now you probably know that I will begin a medical leave of absence July 14. It is unknown when I will return. I'm told that generally these things can take several months. I know I'll have your prayers. And now you know, you will continue to be in my prayer daily, as I "pray for the peace of Jerusalem."

## Fields of Hope & Dreams Community Gardens

We've just started harvesting, but so far this year, our volunteers have made several deliveries to the Cooperating Churches of Sussex's (CCOS) food pantry. We have a long growing season before us, but we're off to a good start.

Along with the plant growth, we have weed growth too. We have four main tools for fighting weeds:



- 1) A one foot perimeter around the outside of the fencing. Most people think this is for flowers to beautify our gardens which the flowers do (thank you Jimmy O) but the other reason is to keep quack grass roots from invading the gardens.
- 2) Bark/mulch in the aisles around the raised beds (thank you Wally S) which keeps weeds away from the planting beds.
- 3) The elevated "raised" beds (thank you Richie S). They provide protection and allow us to plant more densely to crowd out weeds while producing more vegetables per square foot of garden space.
- 4) Our volunteers (thank you – all) who tenderly care for the plants in various ways and that includes: weeding.

This past week, volunteers took on one of the parking lot islands by planting additional irises (thank you Karen B). She generously subdivided irises from home and brought them to help beautify the grounds.
