**PEW VIEW  
WHERE'S YOUR PEW?**

Imagine the assembly area of the church as a farmer's field lined with pews. In today's Gospel Jesus tells the story about the sower spreading seed across the field. The seed, we learn later in the Gospel, is the word of God. The word comes not only in spoken or printed forms but through events that often startle us and are filled with mystery. Perhaps it is in the recent event of Fr. Mike's departure for extended medical leave this weekend that the word of God is "spoken" to us. [If you are unaware of Fr. Mike's leave, please see Fr. Mike's letter in the recent issue of the parish newsletter for complete information.]

Fr. Mike will be gone for a few months, the exact amount of time is unknown. I have been appointed by the Vicar for Priest Personnel to serve as the temporary parish director beginning Monday. According to the appointment letter Fr. Pat Heppe stated that my mission is, "like the archbishop's, one of teaching and administrating the parish, collaborating with the Parish Council and those organizations designated to work with you." In short, it's like being a lay pastor. But I am not ordained and cannot preside at Mass, etc.

Fr. Jerry Hudziak has agreed to continue his scheduled Mass times and has also offered some additional help if possible. Fr. Jerry cannot be expected to assume the full sacramental schedule. He is retired, twice in fact! But he has already kindly taken on some extra Masses including one up-coming wedding and we are grateful! Other help out priests will be recruited and so we will have an opportunity to experience greater variety in our worship and preaching. Hopefully, a priest will be available for all of our weekend Masses, funerals, and those weddings scheduled with Masses. For weekdays the plan now is to have a Word and Communion Service on Tuesday mornings and to have Mass on Wednesday mornings. Our two deacons will be called upon for additional help and they have willingly offered their services.

This change in our "normal operation" can be viewed as God's word coming to us. Where will this word, this "seed" land? Is your pew a "path," stubborn, hard, and unwilling to hear what's happening? Or is your pew "rocky" with no commitment to the community or willingness to work together to discern the meaning of God's word? Maybe your pew sits among the "thorns," and chokes out this opportunity to find meaning by being negative, grumbling, complaining, and spreading rumors. But hopefully all our pews are in "rich soil" where God's word in this event will be reflected upon, supported, nurtured, and eventually come to bear a new crop of faith filled and enthusiastic people in our community.

We send Fr. Mike on his healing journey today with our thoughts, our prayers, and our abundant love and support. We look forward to joyfully welcoming him upon his return. Blessings!

So, where is your pew? Path, rocks, weeds, fertile soil? Let's grow together!

Our warm weather garden – Field of Hope – is showing promise, with tomatoes, peppers and cucumbers growing and off to a good start. We’re confident once our weather heats up, we’ll have another good season.

We continue to reduce the bark/mulch pile, placing mulch between plantings in parking lot islands to help reduce weed growth and beautify our “outer worship space”. Richard Schmidt, Sr. has been a great help. We’re trying to keep up with his weed pulling efforts. Of course it helps when you have two brave ladies (Amy and Gloria) continuing to shovel mulch in spite of uncovering two snakes in the wood pile, which were quickly removed by Wally. Oh the stories they can share - ask them.

Last week’s bulletin shared a “Thank You” from The Green Power Garden Team of Molly Llanas, Sandra Roback & Karen Perlewitz for supplying their garden with starter plants after our plant sale. They raise vegetables in a three acre garden plot and donate to food pantries throughout Waukesha. If we want to help them out again next year, we’ll need more volunteers to germinate seeds and raise starter plants in their homes this winter and early spring. Our “garden” outreach ministry continues to expand beyond the Sussex/Lannon/Hamilton School district area.
