**PEW VIEW**

Archbishop ListECKi began his weekly e-mail “Love One Another” this past Tuesday this way: *“Every priest dreads having to be the celebrant of the funeral Mass for his parents or siblings. But he knows that his witness is important not only for his family, but also for the entire community. We are believers and our sadness is tempered by the promise of the resurrection. We place our confidence in Jesus’ words, which promise that “those who believe in me shall live forever.”*

Ironically, the Archbishop’s letter arrived as Fr. Mike was sitting in my office going over a few details before he and his siblings went to the funeral home to make arrangements for his father’s funeral. Fr. Mike’s father had died of a heart attack on Monday morning. Howard Moran was nearly 85 years old. His birthday would have been Thursday. The funeral for Howard was held here at St. James on Saturday, June 21<sup>st</sup>.

The Archbishop addressed the special pressure that is put upon priests in presiding at the funeral Mass of a close relative like a parent or sibling. There is sometimes a perception that a priest’s sadness and grief should be suppressed as any public display of it might appear to be a counter message to one’s preaching and belief in the promise of the resurrection. But priests are human. They mourn the loss of parents. Their hearts ache. Like most people they wish that there had been one more day with their loved one. But it’s okay to cry. Even Jesus mourned the death of his good friend, Lazarus.

Without a spouse or children a priest has to rely upon extended family for comfort and support at such a time. That “extended family” usually means the “faith family,” the parish communities where the priest has formed special relationships through his ministry. As so many people know, after the death of a loved one tears can swell from within at the seemingly most inopportune times. The pressure might be on a little more for those who preach and teach the Gospel to be strong and to profess emphatically the joy and hope in the resurrection. But so might there be an added responsibility upon the faith community to provide an “extra measure” of support and love.

Well, come to think of it, St. James always provides an “extra measure” of support and love to all who mourn and grieve. How richly blessed we are to have our bereavement ministries. Thank you to those who greet and support families at the visitations and funerals, who acolyte, sing, bring food for a lunch, serve a meal with love and compassion, and provide follow-up care and support. As a community St. James gives strong witness in our belief in the resurrection.

Our condolences to Fr. Mike and his siblings on the loss of their father, Howard. Be assured, as all are who mourn the loss of loved ones, of our continued prayers and love. May Howard Moran rest in peace and share in the joy of eternal life.
