This past week hundreds of parents attended meetings for their children enrolled from the early grades through high school Christian Formation and over 150 people also attended the two parish meetings which offered information about our parish structure, future possibilities, and the annual financial report. *Hello everyone!*

*I'm glad Daryl invited me to send a little message to share with you at the parish meeting. It's now been two plus months since I arrived at the St. John Vianney Center. The food here is so good that I signed up for the weight management program. I've dropped 14 pounds and hope to lose a few more.*

*My basic diagnosis is a low grade depression. I knew something was wrong, but they tell me that I've had this condition for quite some time. I've discovered that a major factor is that through the years my closer friends have either died or moved away and I haven't done much to "replace" them, if that is possible. This is no reflection on St. James parish. I know I have many friends and much support from so many of you. This has more to do with peer friends, such as fellow priests and classmates through the years.*

*And I've learned that my life is much better without the use of alcohol. After all, alcohol is a depressant. That's hardly the right medicine for someone who is depressed! I share this with you because your awareness and support will be very valuable to me. I'm putting together a "continuing care plan" that will be monitored by the St. John Center during the coming year. I will have a support group of three people who know me well. We will meet monthly with a representative of the St. John Center who will be with us with a phone connection. As you can see, this is a very thorough program.*

*September 29 will be my next progress report meeting. Hopefully one of these meetings will give me a discharge date. Even though I've been away from sometime, I will need some "down time" just to relax before being" back in the saddle." Also, I had planned my annual retreat for the Thanksgiving week. I hope to be able to follow through on that as well.*

*I'm very grateful to Daryl, our pastoral staff, Fr. Jerry, and other helping priests for continuing to serve St. James Parish so well. Thanks for your continued prayers, cards, and good wishes. I look forward to seeing you soon.*

**Anointing of the Sick**

The Church has always prayed for the sick to be freed from pain and restored to health. Its pastoral care has its roots in the healing ministry of Jesus. The Lord was always aware of suffering and pain and responded with compassion and healing. The early Church continued Christ's healing ministry. In the Epistle of St. James we read, "Is there anyone who is sick among you? Let him summon the Priests of the Church. They should pray over him and Anoint him with oil in the name of the Lord."

The Health Ministry of St. James will be holding Anointing of the Sick at **all three Masses on October 11th & 12th**. We ask that if you would like to be Anointed that you sit toward the end of the pews and our health ministers will give you a name tag as you come into church to assist the Priests with knowing who is to be Anointed.

It has become our tradition here at St. James to Anoint at our Masses so that the whole church community may take part in the healing ministry. All are welcome to assist with the laying on of the hands as our parishioners are being Anointed.

**FIELDS OF HOPE & DREAMS COMMUNITY GARDENS**

Garden volunteers, members of the Building & Grounds Committees and other good hearted parish volunteers have started developing a new (i.e. third) garden for 2015 this fall.
