- Speaking of "leaks!" we are close to replacing one large water container above the sanctuary of the church, needed for the fire sprinkler system. The original one sprung a leak and needs to be replaced. These things are not cheap! The price tag is \$9,000! Special gifts to help pay for this will be greatly appreciated.

- Monday is the 32nd Annual Chili and Chicken Soup Cook Off at the Sussex Armory. This event provides needed support for the Sussex Outreach Service (SOS) which we fund with our neighboring churches. I plan to make a crock of a "hybrid" chili - chili made with chicken! It's called "Chicken Taco Chili!"

- We're coming near the end of our special month to highlight respect for all stages of life - "from the womb to the tomb," and everything in between. Hopefully something has touched your heart this month to help you be a part of reverencing life in all its stages.

- We're celebrating the sacrament of Anointing of the Sick this weekend. It used to be called "Extreme Unction" - the "last" anointing, and was administered as someone breathed their last. We've returned to the original focus of this sacrament from the early church: praying for healing and the strength needed when sick, or dealing with the aches and pains of aging. If anyone needs this sacrament but can't be present at Mass this weekend, please call me and I'll make a home visit.

- This weekend will be a great opportunity to meet our new parish nurse, Brigitte Glinski. Brigitte plans to be at the Masses in which we are administering this sacrament: 4:30, 8:15, and 10:30.

- The Gospel of Mark today reminds us of Jesus performing one of the works expected from the "Messiah" - giving sight to the blind. How ironic that the man who is physically blind, has great insight of faith. Jesus says to him, *Be on your way! Your faith has healed you!* As we follow the Lord in our own time, "on the way," may we be a source of the Lord's healing, strength, and consolation to those we meet.



**A Note from the Parish Nurse, Brigitte Glinski:**

I am very excited to be the new Parish Nurse here at St. James. I come to St. James after taking a few years away from nursing to spend time with my family, my husband Mike, and my two sons, Joey, age 2 and Nathaniel, 10 months. Prior to staying home I worked at Children's Hospital of Wisconsin in the Trauma/Surgical Intensive Care Unit.

As I step into this role, I ask myself, “What is a Parish Nurse?” As Parish Nurse, it is my job to be a health educator, health counselor, referral specialist, and organizer of volunteers. I am a link between the medical and faith community. Nursing is not just focused on the science of how the body functions in both health and illness; it also takes into account the spiritual aspect of a person's health.

The St. James Health Ministry is comprised of many different ministries. The card ministry sends occasional cards to parishioners just to let them know their church family is thinking of them. The prayer shawl ministry creates beautiful shawls so that recipients will feel wrapped in Jesus' loving arms. Blood pressure screenings are offered a preventative healthcare. Meals are offered to those in need while ill or during a time of bereavement. Eucharistic ministers provide visits to the homebound and hospitalized to allow them to feel God's love during their illness. The Elizabeth Ministry reaches out to moms and their families, and includes the Rosebud program as well as maintaining the busy bags for children age four and under.

Please feel free to contact me if you or a loved one has a need for the services of the health ministry, or if you would like to serve our parish family as part of the health ministry. - **Opening Mass**  
We are hoping that faithful from throughout the Archdiocese will join us for the Opening Mass on Tuesday, December 8, 2015, 5:15 pm, at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist. The Archbishop will formally open the *Year of Mercy* with a proclamation and the blessing of the Cathedral "Holy Door."
- **Closing Mass**  
Mark your calendars now to join us for the closing of the *Year of Mercy* on Sunday, November 20, 2016, 11:00 am, at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist.
- **Pilgrimages to Holy Doors**  
One site in each of the 10 deaneries has been designated as a "Holy Door Pilgrimage Site." Please encourage your members to make pilgrimages to these sites. A "Pilgrims Guide" of prayer resources will be available at each site. The site locations with specific pilgrimage hours will be available soon via email and the website. Also, pdf's of the components of the "Pilgrim's Guide" will be available for download.
- **Havens of Mercy for the Sacrament of Reconciliation**  
The Archdiocesan men's religious orders will function throughout the *Year of Mercy* as "havens" where pilgrims can go to receive God's mercy through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The site locations with specific pilgrimage hours will be available soon via email and the website.
- **Corporal Works of Mercy Pilgrimages**


- **Mercy Months and Mercy Actions**
