From The Servant's Quarters

▪ Another Sunday, another "epiphany" - another manifestation. The Baptism of the Lord makes known to Jesus and to us that he is the Beloved Son in whom the Heavenly Father is well-pleased. This launching of Jesus into his public life and ministry concludes for us this year's celebration of the Christmas Season.

▪ We are reminded that Jesus paved the way for us in every dimension of our lives, including the experience of baptism. He has led us through the transforming death of baptism into the refreshment of new life in Christ. Hopefully by our participation in the experience of Advent and Christmas, we are better able to "make manifest" the presence of God through the quality and love of our lives.



▪ The baptism we have received is more than a water baptism. We have been immersed into the fire-life of the Holy Spirit. Through the Spirit we have been given the means to bring the light of Christ to bear on the experience of darkness in our lives and in the world. The challenge for us is to unwrap the gift of the life of the Spirit and make use of the many gifts the Spirit provides.

▪ One year I gave someone a Christmas gift, all wrapped and looking pretty. Several months later I visited the home of my friend and discovered the gift still piled up in the corner, unopened! Needless to say I was disappointed. My gift did not seem appreciated. Nor was my gift doing my friend any good. He was not making use of my expression of love to enrich his life.

▪ Do we sometimes do that with the gifts of the Holy Spirit? Do we forget that the power and strength of God is there, waiting for us to unwrap it and allow it to enrich our lives?

▪ We too long to hear those words from the clouds that Jesus heard, "You are my beloved one; with you I am well pleased." May our lives be an epiphany - making manifest the presence of our God in the coming year.

▪ I have long ago discovered that one of the greatest resources of our parish is our "retired" members. They devote so much time, talent, energy, and passion to the ministries of our faith community.

They not only give to the parish, they give through the parish to the needs of others. Thank you so much.

▪ Here is another opportunity for one of our retired members to help us out. The wooden chairs in the rectory dining room are becoming unglued! We use the dining room for meetings, and for planning weddings and funerals. The rickety chairs are becoming a safety concern. Who would like to take care of that for us? Your work will be greatly appreciated.

▪ There once was a lady from Guam, Who said, "Now the sea is so calm I will swim, for a lark"; But she met with a shark. Let us now sing the ninetieth psalm.





In planning the layout of our two gardens, experience helps, along with knowledge of crop rotation and compatible planting.
