The Cooperating Churches of Sussex sponsor Operation Backpack as a way to be sure that every child in the Sussex area gets all of the needed school supplies to get the school year off to a great start. As a member of CCOS we can help by donating school supplies and then our collection will be joined with the other CCOS collections to be sure there are plenty of school supplies for every child. Starting in mid July you can check out the bulletin board in fellowship hall for ideas of what to buy and then by August 18th drop off your donations in the large box under the bulletin board. New backpacks, sharpie markers, and high-lighters always seem to be in short supply. Please be careful not to purchase college ruled paper and notebooks since none of the schools want students using that type of paper. More Book reviews

Recently Daryl gave a review of some new additions to our new Lending Library in the Great Room. As I was cleaning my shelves, I found some that I would recommend: The Parish of the next millennium by Fr. William Bausch. This is a summary of the social & cultural forces that shape our lives & our church. Bausch pulls together current research & issues that indicate where we are & where we might be going in our parishes.

The Different Drum by M. Scott Peck. In this book, the author challenges people to a journey of self-awareness: to achieve, through the creative experience of community, a new "connectedness" and wholeness.

The Dance of the Spirit. The Seven steps of Women's Spirituality by Maria Harris. In this powerful & inspiring book, Maria teaches women how to dance to the music of their own souls & discover the spiritual steps that can transform their lives. There are some suggested practices for each of the seven steps.

Dining in the Kingdom by Fr. Eugene LaVerdiere. This book is about the origins of the Eucharist according to Luke. It is about making connections between the Eucharist, the gospel and the worshipping assembly.

Three Cups of Tea by Greg Mortenson & David Relin. A true story about Greg Mortenson a mountaineer who drifted into a impoverished Pakistan village after a failed attempt to climb K2. Moved by the inhabitants' kindness, he promised to return & build a school. This is a riveting adventure & a testament to the power of the humanitarian spirit. It gives great insight into the culture of this country and its people.

When a Friend dies by Marilyn Gootman. This book about grieving and healing is for teens. The author has seen her own children suffer from the death of a friend. If you are a parent or a teacher of a teen, who has experienced a painful loss, this book is for you, too.
