**From The Servants Quarters
July 3, 2011**

• I don't think I've EVER felt so welcomed in all my life as I did last weekend! (Except perhaps when Mother brought me into this world!) Your smiles, hand shakes, and hugs have helped me to feel like I've been "born again!" Thanks so much for your many kindnesses to me as I settle into the life and rhythm of your faith community.

• And Comet thanks you too! His fur is wearing off from being petted so much. That's a good thing. Then there is less to vacuum of his blond tufts rolling across the room.

• I'm also enjoying the vitality of the daily Mass community. What a blessing it is for us to have the Historic Chapel for smaller group worship. Parishioners and pastoral leadership people have done a marvelous job with the overall premises. Friends from my last parish drove by last weekend and they were amazed at what a beautiful campus we have.

• I'm just beginning to get my toe into the water of the various ministries occurring here at St. James. I feel truly blessed to be a part of your parish. It would be helpful for me to know what you treasure most about this community of faith. I'd also like to hear your hopes and dreams for the future. Feel free to drop me a note, send an e-mail, or corner me for a little conversation.

• A little over a year ago I became friends with Sister Angela, a Medical Mission sister from Tanzania. She was a part of my sabbatical group as I took some refresher courses at Berkeley, California. Toward the end of the program she asked for my help for some friends of hers in Tanzania. The husband of her friend, Elizabeth, died, leaving her with three children. They were living in abject poverty and did not have the money to go to school. She asked me to raise \$2,000 so her friend could start a chicken farm. I did that this past year with the help of parishioners at St. Mary in West Bend. She also asked for \$800 to be sent to them twice a year to pay the tuition for the children. We have completed the first year of that as well. The chicken farm is doing well. The family now enjoys better living conditions. And the children are completing their second semester in school. In November I need to wire another \$800 to Sister Angela for tuition.

I own one week of a two bedroom timeshare condo at Wisconsin Dells. Perhaps someone would like to make use of that in exchange for helping me with this tuition project. You can check out the resort at www.festiva-tamarack.com. The available week is September 18 – 25.

• I'm sure I can also count on your prayers for Sister Angela, Elizabeth, and her three children.
