Dear Friends,

We are hosting and feeding between 250-500 homeless people on **Saturday, July 4th**. On that day, as on other holidays, the majority of other programs serving homeless people are closed. We are happy to provide our people with a place to go. We will open at 7 am and close at 5 pm. We will serve the noon meal between 11:30-1:30 pm. On one summer holiday in the past our count was 450--the highest number we ever hosted.

The homeless people lead and govern this event. Our homeless leadership, plus a delegation from Vets Place Central (a residential life formation program for homeless vets) will be in the heavy duty roles, especially the cooking/serving and front desk situations.

How can friends of Repairers of the Breach help?

1. You can be there helpfully but in a minor role. We appreciate volunteers helping to carry trays for the disabled or elderly, or for families with small children. Our population includes people in severe hardship. Also, you may be there to get acquainted and have conversations, to be "present," and to enjoy sharing this event. You are welcome to attend God's banquet (Luke 14:13 "When you give a feast, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind.") Also, try reading Matthew 22:1-10.
2. We are not requesting donations of food. We have learned from past experiences that the food on the plates needs to be as consistent as possible, which is why we choose to serve one kind of meat, for example. The majority of our food donations are contributed in response to the efforts of Carmella Thomas, our Events Coordinator.
3. We welcome small monetary donations. Assisting with some costs and supplies are The Gathering (St. James), Imperial Flavor Beverages, Keebler Cookies, Klements Sausage, and Mount Mary College. But we need help with the utility costs of accommodating such a large number of people. Our water bill is very high, for example due to the heavy use of showers and toilets.

We also provide prizes (phone cards) for winners of our tournaments: dominoes, spades, and chess. If you are moved to help us with any of these expenses, please send a check to Repairers of the Breach, P.O. Box 13791 Milwaukee, WI 53213. It is not advisable to drop off cash at the center or even checks, due to the level of activity there--and also not to tempt anyone. We appreciate financial help very much--even a donation of \$5.00 is appreciated.

What Repairers of the Breach has created for the homeless on holidays for the past 14 years, and will create on July 4th again, serves for many as their family picnic. Each event is a living demonstration of the capacity of our people to self-govern. Our own people provide security all day long. We have never had an incident of violence all these years or any drug activity on the premises during holiday events. We gather for prayer at 8:00 am and it flows from there. We could not do this without the prayers of the people and help from the larger community. We are all very tired at the end of the day but we are all smiling.

4th Annual Day Trip to the Kalahari

\$40.00 gets you a pass for the indoor and outdoor waterpark as well as unlimited use of the New Theme Park a super slice of pizza and a bottle of soda. Pizza is for lunch....other snacks and dinner is the kid's responsibility. (sometimes we stop at Culvers on our way home)

Total Cost for this Trip without St. James transportation \$40.00. With the Bus \$50.00. The Kalahari is normally \$40.00 a person and the Theme park is \$35.00 a person that doesn't include food.

We hope you will consider sharing your faith in some way with our young people.
