## **Pentecost Sunday**

---

Jesus said to his disciples: “Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him.” — Jn 14:23



*From The Servant's Quarters*

• If I asked you to think about the ideal attorney, who would come to mind? Ben Matlock? Perry Mason? Someone you've experienced personally? An ideal attorney stands by you when you are in trouble. S/he holds nothing back to prove your innocence and help you navigate the foreign waters of the legal system. If you are guilty, s/he goes to great lengths to minimize the negative consequences to you.

• In biblical times "parakletos" or paraclete was just this type of helper and representative. Literally the word means, "called to the side of;" "advocate." Jesus promised the Paraclete to his disciples to return to the help them cope with His Father. "I will not leave you orphans," Jesus reassures them.



• When Jesus made this pledge He included those who would come after his first followers - you and me! Isn't that great news? This weekend, Pentecost, we celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit, the Paraclete. (My eighth grade nun was Sister Paraclete! I thought it odd at the time, but now appreciate the name so much more.)

• Our first reception of this Divine Gift was at baptism. Every other sacramental celebration after that is an opportunity to expand our openness to the Spirit. The gifts the Spirit brings empowers us to live *LIFE IN CHRIST*.

• In our history, various poems have been written in celebration of major feasts. We seldom use them anymore at Mass. But the one for Pentecost is my favorite. Here it is to assist us in appreciating the advocacy of the Holy Spirit.

***Come Holy Spirit, come!  
And from your celestial home  
Shed a ray of light divine!  
Come, Father of the poor!  
Come, source of all our store!  
Come within our bosoms shine!  
You of comforters the best;  
You, the soul's most welcome guest;  
Sweet refreshment here below;  
In our labor, rest most sweet;  
Grateful coolness in the heat;  
Solace in the midst of woe.  
O most blessed Light divine,  
Shine within these hearts of thine,  
And our inmost being fill!  
Where you are not, man has naught,  
Nothing good in deed or thought,  
Nothing free from taint of ill.  
Heal our wounds, our strength renew;  
On our dryness pour your dew;  
Wash the stains of guilt away;  
Bend the stubborn heart and will;
