## The Christmas Giving Tree

The Christmas Giving Tree, located in the Gathering Area beginning this weekend, is filled with gift tags with donation requests from the following organizations. Select a gift tag of your choosing and the organization's desired donation will be listed on the tag. All donations are to be returned to St. James and placed under the Giving Tree no later than December 9<sup>th</sup>. Your donations mean so much to the recipients and organizations, so please consider supporting the Christmas Giving Tree. Here are the organization highlights:

***Sussex Outreach Services:*** The Sussex Outreach Services organization holds an annual Christmas Gift program, where area parents of children in need are allowed to select one gift of their choice. Your donation of an unwrapped toy, game, or clothing item will ensure that all children connected with the SOS program will be able to receive a gift.

***St. Vincent de Paul Society of St. James:*** This St James Parish based group responds to parish needs in many ways, but most frequently in emergency situations that include power shut offs or imminent evictions. Please donate Cash (checks payable to St. Vincent de Paul Society), gift cards to Pick 'n Save or Gas Station gift cards, which are especially needed this year. These donations will assist individuals or families in our parish area who have come upon extremely difficult times.

***Interfaith:*** This faith-based Waukesha County non-profit organization runs a Holiday Gift Program which provides a gift envelope of items to low-income homebound seniors and adults with disabilities. Please provide a \$10 gift card to either Walgreens or Pick 'n Save, a \$5 gift card from McDonald's or a book of stamps for Interfaith to include in their gift.

***Milwaukee Center for Independence:*** This non-profit organization works with inner-city, poverty stricken families with developmentally delayed or disabled children, particularly the ages from birth to 3 years old. MCFI holds an annual Christmas Party for these families and provides gift certificates for food, clothing or pharmaceutical/personal needs. Please donate Gift Cards of \$5 - \$20 from Wal-Mart, Pick 'n Save, or Target.

***Hebron House:*** This non-profit organization provides emergency housing and related services to people in transition with the basic needs of shelter, food and personal support. Please donate specific gift as listed on the gift tag. These are gifts that will be given to a current resident at Hebron House.

• We begin a special focus this weekend on the financial dimension of the spirituality of stewardship. I'm very grateful to those who are speaking to us this weekend about keeping our parish financially healthy. People who have embraced a lifestyle of Biblical stewardship have many stories to tell as to how the Lord blesses us in special ways when we attempt to place God first in our lives. Making our financial gift to the parish the first concern in writing out checks for the month is a very concrete way of showing gratitude to God for God's many blessings to us.

• Biblical stewardship uses the term "tithe" which means 10% of one's resources. Some may decide not to take this literally because there are many other charitable causes that make a claim on our personal finances. It helps to keep in mind that in Biblical times, the tithe was every charitable response wrapped up into one gift. This was their tax system, their United Way, Temple and their care for the religious needs. So to adapt this to our own times, one might take 10% of one's gross income and divide it up with the first portion going to the church, and the remaining amount distributed among other charities. A key factor of this approach is using some *percentage* of one's income rather than just a flat dollar amount. At the risk of sounding like the "Buffett Rule" this sense of proportional giving predates today's millionaires!

The new Field of Hope garden, started last spring, doubled the available planting space from our original Field of Dreams garden, started three years ago. This allowed volunteers to place plants more suitable to sun/shade, temperature and woodchuck conditions which more than doubled our donations to the Cooperating Churches of Sussex's (CCOS) and Menomonee Falls' food pantries. Garden volunteers – pick, wash, dry, bag (in Ziploc bags), label (with Field of Dreams labels), box, and document all produce in our Community Center's kitchen before delivering it to the food pantries.
