- The finance council is reviewing by-laws for the Legacy Fund. The by-law document will also undergo legal scrutiny. A letter explaining the purpose of the fund is also being drafted.
- Post cards about St. James are being sent to new residents in Sussex and the Town of Lisbon.
- An ad hoc committee is working on Strategic Planning. A document containing the actions steps for the 3-5-7-year Strategic Plan is under development.
- Council members asked Joe to provide an update on the current budget in January.

- Pat Buehler asked members to reflect and pray about the remaining items.
- Our Discussion and Discernment of Focus will continue at the January meeting.
