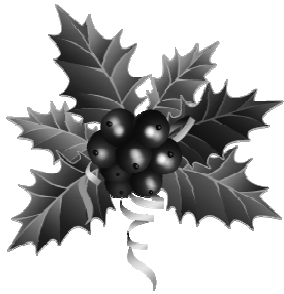

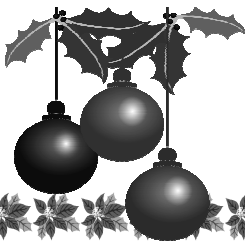

For December Nametag weekend coincides with HOLLY DAYS on December 7th & 8th.

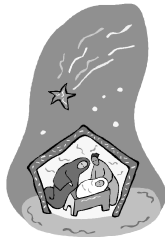

We have now rolled into "the holidays." For many people, extra pounds roll on along with the favorite holiday foods and treats. Here are 10 tips to enjoy healthy nutrition and maintain your weight through the holiday season.



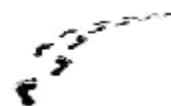
1. **Eat breakfast.** Studies show people who eat breakfast take in fewer calories during the day.
2. **Plate it.** Putting food on a plate, rather than grazing at a holiday party, helps you be more mindful of what you're eating and how much.
3. **Portion control.** Grab a smaller plate to help manage the temptation to put more on your plate than you need.
4. **Start with veggies.** Eat a few healthy vegetables first to curb your appetite before sampling holiday treats.
5. **Choose proteins.** Nuts, low-fat dairy, legumes, and lean meat in healthy portions will help you feel full.
6. **Skip it.** If you don't love it, don't eat it!

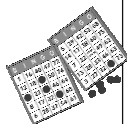
