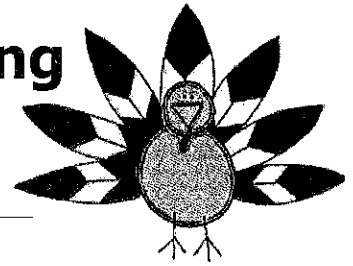


3K - Session 8 – Thanksgiving

Chapter Materials: Thanksgiving

Prayer Ideas:

- ☺ Gather some fall items to look at together – they could be things from outside like leaves & acorns, or decorations that you use in your home.
- ☺ You might want to use the Thanksgiving Day Prayer that is found on the children's handout.
- ☺ Ask your child to verbalize one thing that they are thankful for. You might offer a few things that you are thankful for as well.

Teach:

- ☺ God wants us to be thankful for all the good things we have. How do we show that we are thankful? See what your child can suggest and share a few ways that 3 year olds can show their thanks.
- ☺ Read the Take Home Story to your child.
- ☺ If you have a Thanksgiving storybook at home, that would be a nice activity.
- ☺ There are a finger play and a song that you could do with your child.
- ☺ Create a thankful turkey using the included lesson materials. Each turkey feather has something that we can be thankful for. Help your child to name some things to write on the blank feathers.

Five Little Turkeys

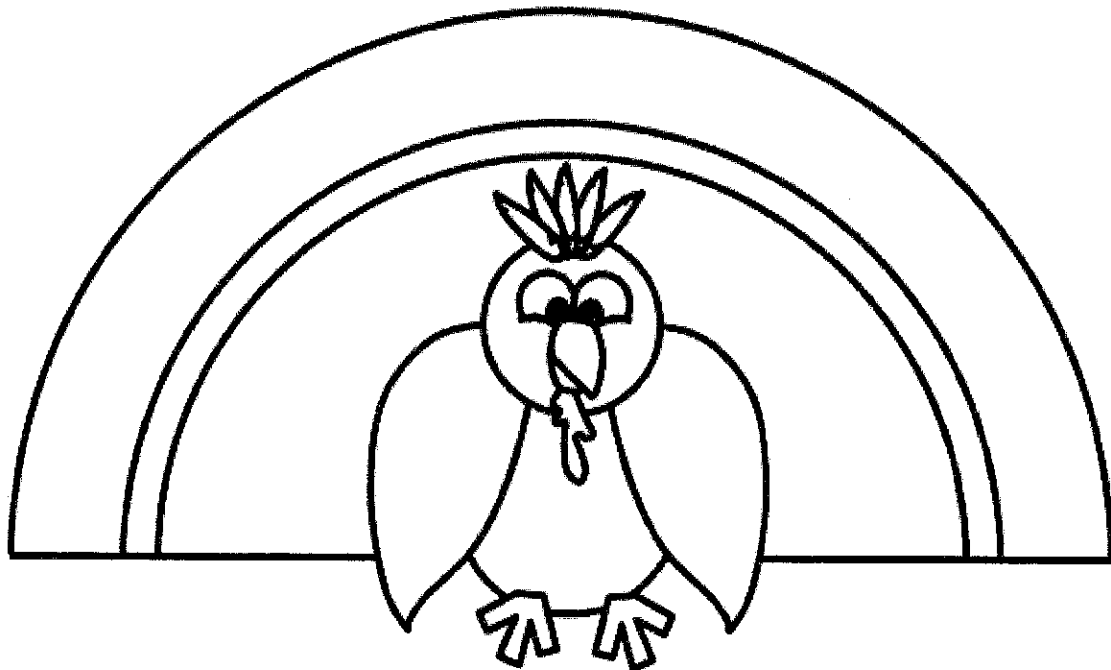
Five little turkeys standing at the door,

One waddled off, and then there were three.

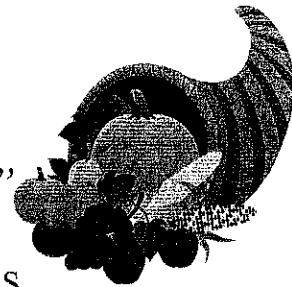
Three little turkeys with nothing to do,
