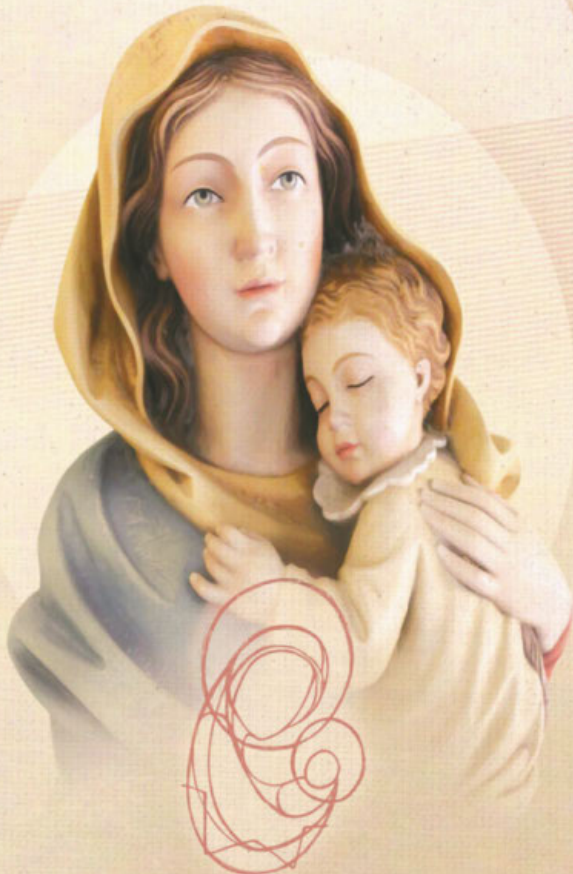

GLUTEN FREE HOSTS

Take a gluten host, place it in a pyx (also in the freezer) Place the pyx in the gold offertory bowl at the back of the church. At communion, go to receive from Father. As you approach let Father know you need the gluten free. Clean the container and return to the freezer.

BLOOD PRESSURE MINISTRY

The American Heart Association reports that nearly half of all Americans over age twenty have high blood pressure, which increases their risk of heart attack, stroke, and other health threats. High blood pressure usually has no symptoms, so it is important to have your blood pressure checked regularly.

Blood Pressure Ministry volunteers will be available in the Great Room to check your blood pressure following all Masses next weekend. Educational materials from the American Heart Association will be available.

Our Bereavement Companion Ministry is available to walk with you thru the days and weeks ahead. The funeral does not have to have taken place at St. James or even in Wisconsin. 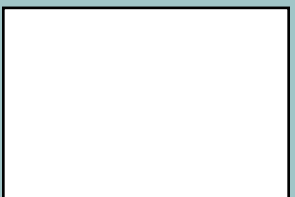
