St. James and Good Shepherd Anti-Human Trafficking Ministry

January is Human Trafficking Awareness Month. Common misconception #1 about Human Trafficking.

Excerpts taken from U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, LET'S TALK, National Slavery and Human Trafficking Prevention Month, Vol. 1, Issue 1, Jan. 3, 2023.

Victims of human trafficking are predominately undocumented or foreign-born.

Throughout the years, there have been several misconceptions about human trafficking, and many national and international political issues have been stereotyped for the general population. This includes the assumption that undocumented immigrants or individuals “illegally” migrating from other countries, are most often the victims of trafficking. Undocumented individuals are vulnerable and are often manipulated and threatened due to their immigration status. Their legal status often isolates them from legal resources, family members, language barriers, and other issues which help traffickers exploit this population. Nevertheless, many U.S. citizens or legally residing persons are caught in human trafficking and exploited as a consequence. Native-born runaway children, for example, are particularly at risk to individuals who seek to exploit their vulnerability.
