## Lent 2023

The 2023 Lenten season begins with the observance of Ash Wednesday on Feb. 22.

The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent. For this reason:

Catholics who have celebrated their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent;

Catholics who have celebrated their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Hence, on those days they may eat only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those days. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59<sup>th</sup> birthday.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

# Matthew 25 Lent | The Earth is the Lord's and they that Dwell in it.

The focus this Lent is to start the conversation to have parishioners, youth, and adults, informed and understand the urgency of Creation Care affecting our faith, the poor, and our health. Pope Francis's Encyclical Laudato Si will be our guide in animating these conversations.

Pope Francis shares, "If we approach nature and the environment without this openness to awe and wonder, if we no longer speak the language of fraternity and beauty in our relationship with the world, our attitude will be that of masters, consumers, ruthless exploiters, unable to set limits on their immediate needs. By contrast, if we feel intimately united with all that exists, then sobriety and care will well up spontaneously." Pope Francis urgently appeals to all persons "for a new dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet."

How is God calling you to be **protectors of God's Earth**? One way is to take a **Leap of Faith Card** from the pedestal on the altar and commit to do a corporal and spiritual works of mercy and One Simple Act to care for creation.

The Matthew25 bulletin articles will focus on the goals of the **Laudato Si Action Platform** that provides concrete actions to care for our common home.
