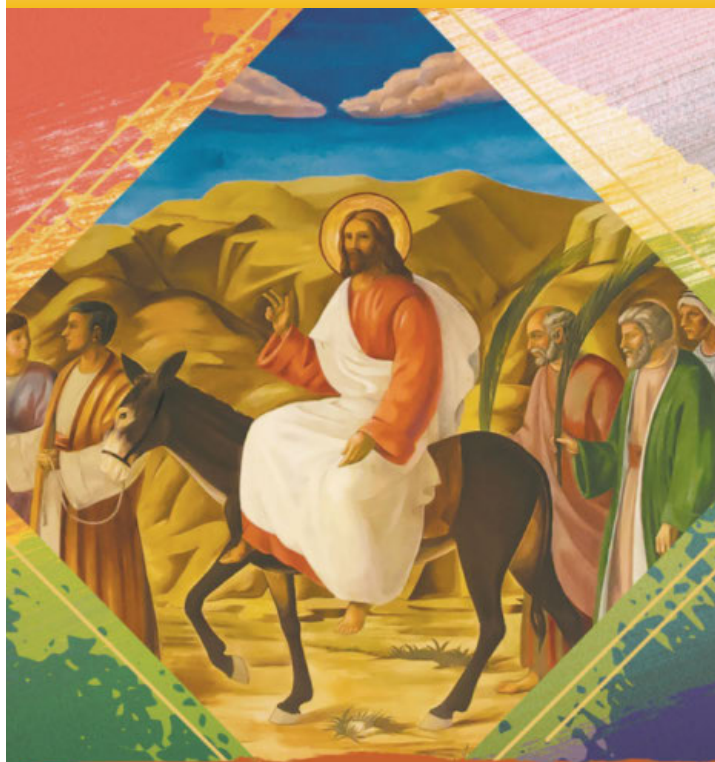

As you approach let Father know you need the gluten free. Clean the container and return to the freezer.

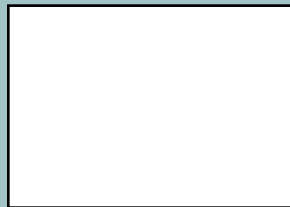

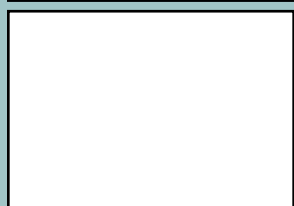
