The individual receives from the Holy Spirit the graces of "strengthening, peace, and courage to overcome the difficulties that go with the condition of serious illness or frailty of old age. <u>" CCC</u> **1520** 

Anointing of the Sick will take place at St. James immediately following all Masses during the weekend of March 25<sup>th</sup> and 26th. Parishioners will be invited to remain in their seats following Mass if they wish to be anointed.
