Last weekend we kicked off the Love One Another Campaign at St. James. The goal of St. James is to raise \$1,446,516 in 5-year pledges. Here are the updated totals as of April 26, 2023: St. James has received 66 pledges totaling \$591,200 for 41% of our goal. 60% of the funds pledged and fulfilled with go toward establishing our financial security with a creation of an endowment fund, building and grounds updates addressing short and long term anticipated needs, and supplementing a line of credit to fund unforeseen emergency expenses. We will also make improvements to our audio sound system, install new parish signage, and enhance our outreach. Lastly, we will continue restoration on our 171 year old chapel. The remaining funds will support vital Catholic ministries in southeastern Wisconsin. If we surpass our goal, we will receive an even greater percentage of the funds raised.
