ST. JAMES COMMUNITY GARDENS

If you look at the Field of Dreams garden, you will notice some changes. There are two blaze orange ribbons surrounding three sides of the garden and yellow caution tape along the back side of the garden. These are to help keep deer from jumping the fence and grazing on our vegetable crops. Footprints have been found in several raised beds. Our lettuce has been mowed down to the ground, so we suspect deer or another culprit, a woodchuck. We have dealt with both in past years. Woodchucks like piles of wood. To fend off woodchucks, we will have to trap it and relocate it 10+ miles from the church grounds so it can not find it way back. Deer, woodchucks, and ground squirrels keep us battling for our crops for the CCOS food pantry. Nature's creatures need food too. We just don't want them to steal our crops.
