Message from Father John

The common cup will return at Mass the weekend of June 11, 2023. It is appropriate that we return to this communion practice on the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. I would like to remind those who approach the Eucharistic Minister for Communion that you bow your head and when shown the host and minister states, "The Body of Christ" the communicant responds, "Amen." The consecrated host is placed in the hand or on the tongue and the communicant consumes it. The same with the communion cup. The communicant approaches the Eucharistic Minister, and you bow your head and when the minister states, "The Blood of Christ" the communicant responds, "Amen." The communicant then takes the communion cup and drinks from it, one should never intinct (dip) the host in the communion cup. If you do not wish to receive from the communion cup that is permissible. One receives the fullness of the Eucharistic Presence of Christ in either form, the Body or the Blood.

I would ask for your patience and understanding as we return to this communion practice.
