

## ST. JAMES COMMUNITY GARDENS

Our community here at St. James is a very "responsive and giving community" Last week I asked for live traps to help me catch woodchucks on our church property. Traps were dropped off at church. The first question I was asked upon my arrival at church was: "Did you get the trap?" The second question was: "What's the current count?" As of last Sunday, the count was: four raccoons, two woodchucks, one opossum, and a very ugly weasel. All have been relocated to Monches' Nature Conservancv. Woodchucks are territorial, so the removal of a couple of woodchucks may just clear the area for others. Time will tell, so we will keep trapping. Thank you for your support of our community gardens and the CCOS food pantry. The more varmints we remove, the less they eat and the more food we donate to the food pantry.
