



Looking for a simple ministry to get involved in? St James & Good Shepherd Anti-Trafficking Ministry makes lunch once a month for Franciscan Peacemakers Street Ministry. Lunch delivery date this month is Friday, August 25th. An email with items to donate is sent out via email called "Sign Up Genius". You can select an item or offer to make sandwiches.

THEN: Bring sandwiches and lunch items to St. James cafeteria at 11am on Friday, August 25th.

Stay and HELP assemble (if possible) non-perishable items into lunch bags in the Cafeteria/Hall Kitchen at St. James. Enter at the Christian Formation door on the north side of the building. Assist with placing nonperishable items into the brown lunch bags. (Sandwiches do not go in bags as they are perishable and get refrigerated separately when they arrive). The lunch bags will be in the kitchen along with boxes for transport. Please also assist with carrying items out to the driver's car. We expect that it will take an additional 15-20 minutes of your time. Many hands make fast work.

NOTE: SANDWICHES ARE DELIVERED (by a volunteer driver) to Franciscan Peacemakers.

The Community Banquet is a free, hot meal which allows an opportunity for fellowship with others throughout our communities and faith traditions. This meal is prepared and served at St. James but is provided through a rotation of our Cooperating Churches of Sussex Parishioners who volunteer to take turns in preparing the meal, serving and cleaning up.

The banquet coordinator facilitates the coordination of St. James volunteers to participate in setting up, serving, or cleaning up at a meal when it is our turn. The commitment to coordinate preparing the meal is approximately once every six months. A binder of procedures is available to guide your work.

The Community Banquet meal is a long standing tradition and is served the 2nd & 4th Thursday of the month. It is not held on Thanksgiving.
