# "Forming the Catechetical Spirit" BASIC Religious Education Certification Program

### Who may participate in this program?

This program is designed for <u>ALL INTERESTED ADULTS</u>, including current Parish Catechists. A <u>Parish Catechist</u> is a person who teaches in a parish catechetical program for Adults, Youth, and/or Children.

#### What is required to be a Parish Catechist?

The Wisconsin Catholic Conference requires a Parish Catechist to obtain BASIC Religious Education Certification within five years AND be a Practicing Catholic. BASIC Religious Education Certification is a recognition of professional development in Scripture, Theology, Methods / Psychology, and Spiritual Formation at a foundational level of competence, equivalent to at least 40 clock hours. A Practicing Catholic is a Catholic in good standing who participates fully in the worship and life of the Church, and who understands and accepts the teachings of the Church and moral demands of the Gospel, as articulated in the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

#### **How do I receive BASIC Certification?**

Parish Catechists in the Archdiocese of Milwaukee earn certification by attending pre-approved clock hours in Scripture (15 hours), Theology (15 hours), and Methods / Psychology (10 hours) OR by completing a competency-based program. Certification is available at the BASIC, INTERMEDIATE, and ADVANCED levels. Any level of certification must be completed in 5 years.

## Do I need to attend the whole program?

To receive BASIC Certification, you must complete the entire program. If you have completed some clock hours in the past five years, then fewer classes are required. Please include a record of your clock hours with your registration. The program director has a listing of what category of clock hours are covered at each session. Consult that list to complete your remaining hours.

#### What if I miss a class?

All 40 hours must be completed to receive your BASIC Certification. To make up a missed class, a maximum of 2 independent study classes are available. The program may be offered again in the future, so making up classes in subsequent years may be an option. The advantages to attending the entire program in one year are 1) the topics are systematic, 2) an adult learning format is used, and 3) a local community of catechists can form.

#### Is there a fee?

In gratitude for your service to the parish, there is NO fee. If you do not already own them, you will need to purchase a *New American Bible* (recommend *The Catholic Study Bible*, 2<sup>nd</sup> edition, softcover) and the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (recommend 2<sup>nd</sup> edition, green softcover). *Your parish may provide these.* 

## Does my Certification need to be renewed?

Certification at any level is valid for three years. It can be renewed at the same level if 15 clock hours of "maintenance" have been completed in a three year period.
