

One Percent Challenge to Know Jesus Better

We are entering week three of the 1% Challenge. If you don't have a card, here are the steps and Scripture Passages.

Steps of the Challenge:

Prepare (1 minute) Breathe and become aware of Jesus Recognize (2 minutes) Acknowledge your thoughts, feelings... Relate (1 minute) Talk to Jesus about how you are doing. Receive (4 minutes) Read the scripture passages a couple of times, be still and listen for His response.

Daily Scripture Passages:

Day 22: Matthew 25:31-40 Day 26: Matthew 26:36-46 Day 23: John 12:1-8 Day 27: Luke 23:33-47 Day 24: John 13:1-17 Day 28: John 20:1-18 Day 25: Luke 22:14-20

Respond-Talk it Over (3 minutes) Talk to Jesus from your heart about what in the Scripture stands out to you.

Rest - Just be With God (3 minutes) Simply relax in God's presence.

Resolve (1 minute) Thank God for all he has done for you this day and pray for any prayer intentions.
