ANOINTING OF THE SICK-NEXT WEEKEND

The Anointing of the Sick is a sacrament of healing appropriate not only for those in immediate danger of death but also for those suffering from chronic illness or preparing for surgery. The individual receives from the Holy Spirit the graces of "strengthening, peace, and courage to overcome the difficulties that go with the condition of serious illness or frailty of old age. " CCC 1520

Anointing of the Sick will take place at St. James immediately following all Masses during the weekend of October 14th and 15th. Parishioners will be invited to remain in their seats following Mass if they wish to be anointed.

If you are unable to attend on October 14th or 15th and wish to receive the sacrament, please contact the parish office.
