This process had been discontinued during COVID.  • Human Concerns – Jeff Kenkel – April tithing requests went to St. Michael and St. Rose Literacy Program and the Open Door Café. During Lent, 150 Matthew 25 cards were taken. This was a good response so they plan to repeat this next year. Ellacuria Fair Trade sales will be held on June 10th and 11 <sup>th</sup> . We will be donating \$375 of the \$1,502 collected in the Rice Bowls, to support the next trip to Ellacuria. Jeff confirmed that Kristin Winter is the staff member associated with HC. Human Trafficking will have a table at both Menomonee Falls Night Out and Sussex Night Out August 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> .  • Christian Formation – Fr. John – The S.O.U.L. program had a good turnout this year. First communion was held at masses the last couple of weekends. Confirmation is this week. They are getting ready for a mission trip this summer. Vacation Bible School will be called "STELLAR".  • Stewardship – Fr.
