#### **Anointing of the Sick**

The Anointing of the Sick is a sacrament of healing appropriate not only for those in immediate danger of death but also for those suffering from chronic illness or preparing for surgery. The individual receives from the Holy Spirit the graces of "strengthening, peace, and courage to overcome the difficulties that go with the condition of serious illness or frailty of old age. " CCC 1520

Anointing of the Sick will take place at St. James immediately following all Masses during the weekend of March 9th and 10th. Parishioners will be invited to remain in their seats following Mass if they wish to be anointed.

If you are unable to attend on March 9th or 10th and wish to receive the sacrament, please contact the parish office.

#### **Blood Pressure Screening**

The American Heart Association reports that nearly half of all Americans over age twenty have high blood pressure, which increases their risk of heart attack, stroke, and other health threats. High blood pressure usually has no symptoms, so it is important to have your blood pressure checked regularly.

Blood Pressure Ministry volunteers will be available in the Great Room to check your blood pressure following all Masses next weekend, March 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. Educational materials from the American Heart Association will be available.

## In their thirst for water, the people grumbled... (Exodus 17:3-7)

Clean drinking water has been an issue, since before the days of Moses. And why shouldn't it be? It comprises about 60% of our bodies and we can only live about 3 days without it. The good news is 73% of the global population has access to clean drinking water. The bad news is 27% don't. It's a worldwide issue, and also a local one: *in Milwaukee, drinking water often contains lead*, leading to issues for children's brain development. Often, we quench our thirst with bottled water. While it may be convenient, unlike tap water, bottled water is not regulated. It often tests positive for heavy metals, PFAS, and microplastic particles that get into our body systems. AND the process of producing, transporting, distributing and disposing of plastic bottles is harmful to our common home.

Kate, our "plastic free Lent Monitor", asks, "How are we doing on reducing the single use plastic plastics, especially bottled water?"




