Lent 2024

The Catholic Church asks each member to preserve the penitential character and purpose of Lent. For this reason:

Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and each Friday of Lent;

Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, in addition to abstaining from meat, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Hence, on those days they may eat only one full meal. Smaller quantities of food may be taken at two other meals, but no food should be consumed at other times during those days. The obligation of fasting ceases with the celebration of one's 59th birthday.

Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.



Rend your hearts (Joel 2:12-18)

"Industry is wonderful to have, but if it's killing the people in the area that they live in, what good is industry?" Few people realize that single use plastics is not just about recycling and landfills. It's not just about fossil fuels that are used to produce plastics.

It's also about the real toll that pollution from plastic production takes on people in communities like La-Place, Louisiana - commonly known as "Cancer Alley." Located outside LaPlace, the nation's only production plant for neoprene (a synthetic rubber that's found in almost everything) emits 99% of the nation's chloroprene pollution. Chloroprene exposure can lead to respiratory problems, skin issues, chest pains, neurological problems, and an increased likelihood of cancer. On any given day, the level of chloroprene can exceed 700 times the EPA recommended safe levels.

So, what can we do? Kate, our "Plastic Free Lent Mentor" shares some thoughts:

I don't lug heavy water bottles home from the store. Fill a thermos from the tap!

My trash can doesn't overflow with "throw away" containers that aren't recyclable.

My laundry strips are far less messy and less bulky than liquid detergent.

Reusable shopping bags are great -except when I forget to bring them and unload groceries one by one. Leave bags in the car!

Instead of viewing these changes as a hassle, Kate says "I connect my faith with my actions and view each as a small sacrifice offered in prayer and thanksgiving ... And maybe along the way, I'm rending my heart."

Our St. James Parish Community invites all of us to reduce our (single use) plastics this Lent. Spread the word!


