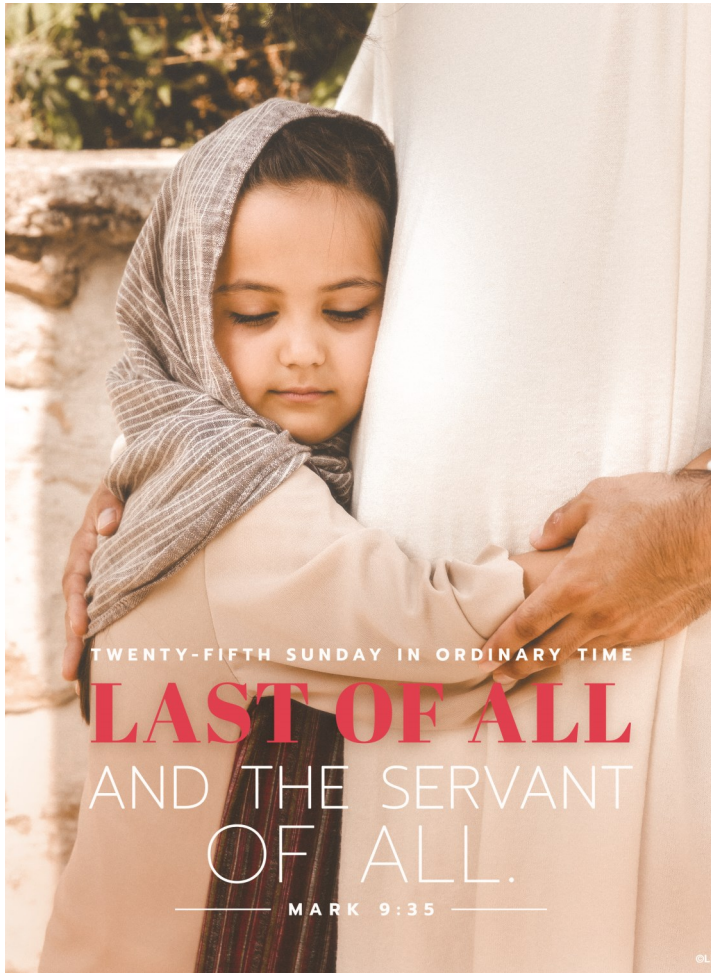

Vincentian Spirituality

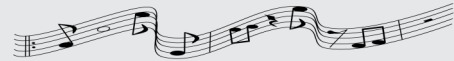
