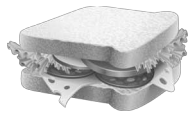

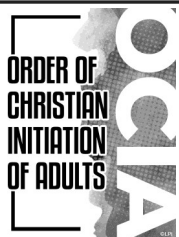

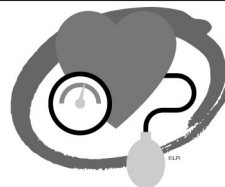

**Anointing of the Sick**

The Anointing of the Sick is a sacrament of healing appropriate not only for those in immediate danger of death but also for those suffering from chronic illness or preparing for surgery. The individual receives from the Holy Spirit the graces of "strengthening, peace, and courage to overcome the difficulties that go with the condition of serious illness or frailty of old age." CCC 1520

Anointing of the Sick will take place at St. James immediately following all Masses during the weekend of January 31st and February 1st. Parishioners will be invited to remain in their seats following Mass if they wish to be anointed. If you are unable to attend and wish to receive the sacrament, please contact the parish office.

**Blood Pressure Screening**

The American Heart Association reports that nearly half of all Americans over age twenty have high blood pressure, which increases their risk of heart attack, stroke, and other health threats. High blood pressure usually has no symptoms, so it is important to have your blood pressure checked regularly.

Blood Pressure Ministry volunteers will be available to check your blood pressure following all Masses on January 31st and February 1st.
