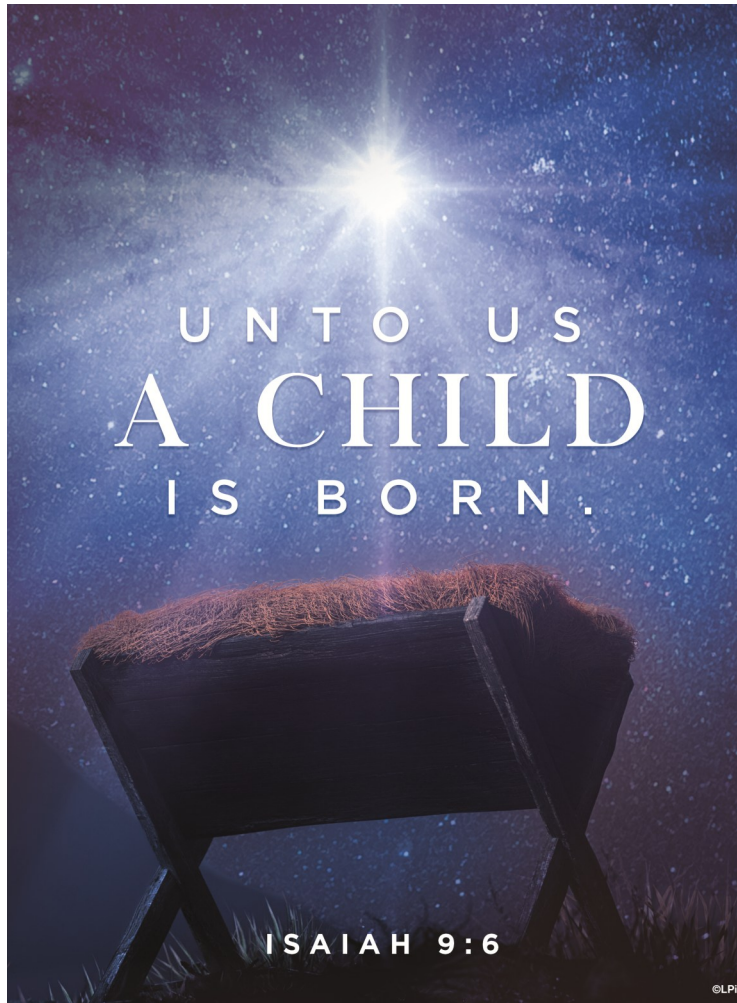

### Adult Confirmation

**Anointing of the Sick** is a sacrament that offers God's grace and peace during times of physical or emotional suffering. In the past, people commonly referred to it as "Last Rites." It is important to understand that although this sacrament *can* be celebrated in a person's final moments, it is preferred that the faithful not wait until then.

Anyone who is seriously injured, seriously ill, preparing for surgery, or of advanced age may request anointing. Arranging it ahead of time increases the likelihood that a priest will be available and allows the person to receive the sacrament more fully.
