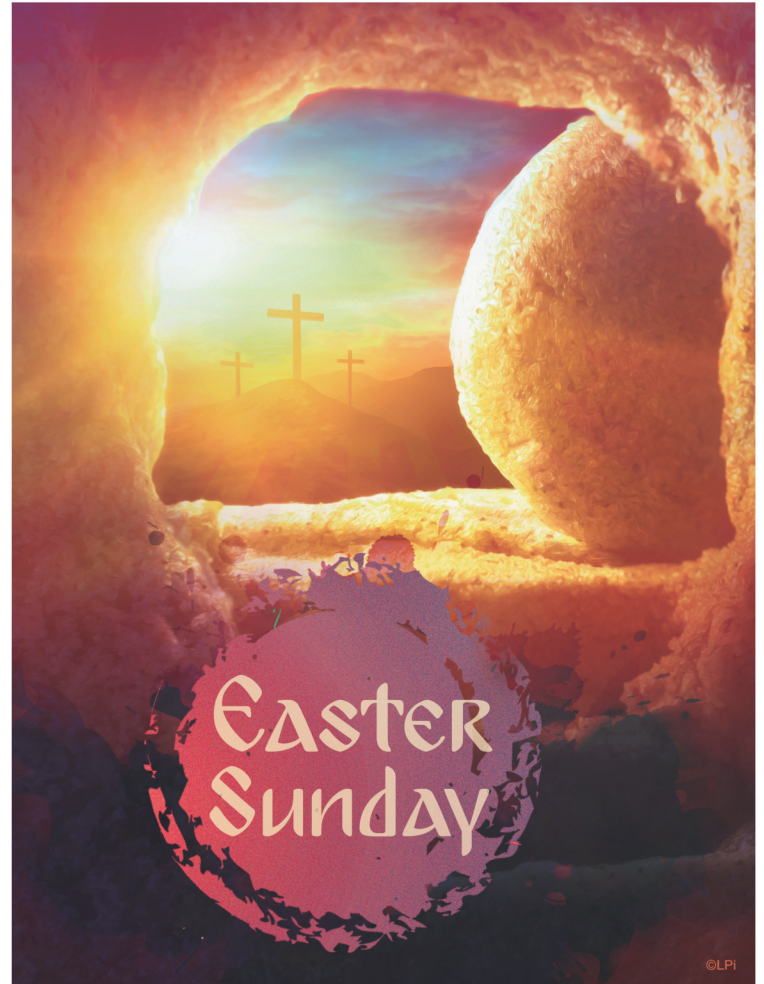

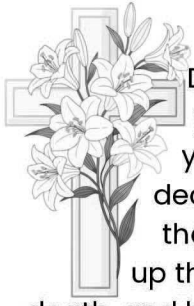

BEHIND THE SCENES - ACOLYTE

Acolyte—do you know what or, better yet, who that is? The very word sounds like a vocabulary question on a College Board exam. While it does have a long church history, coming originally from Greek, the answer is quite simple...acolyte is the official name for a server, one who assists the priest and deacon during mass.

You've seen the acolytes assisting the priest and deacon during mass. Acolytes are part of the processional at the beginning of mass, they hold the book for the priest at the beginning and end of mass and set the altar table and accompany the priest to receive the gifts. They hold the Lavabo (the bowl the priest uses to wash his hands) and also a towel for him to dry his hands.

This may sound complicated, but there is both training and support. Experienced acolytes sit next to a new acolyte until they decide they are ready to be an acolyte on their own.

In addition to attending training, acolytes need to have received the sacraments of Baptism and Communion. St. James has had acolytes as young as eleven. As for time commitments, acolytes sign up for the masses that fit their schedule.
