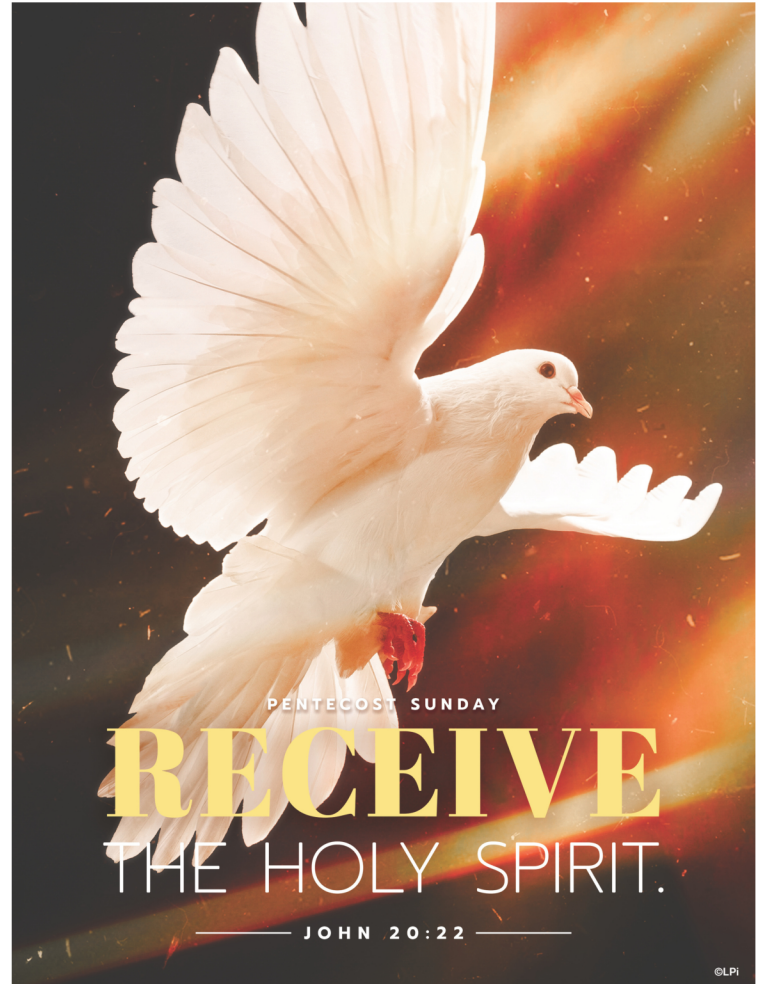

Attention Gardeners!

Beginning the weekend of June 6th & 7th and running through September 5th & 6th we would like to use flowers from parishioners' gardens in our sanctuary environment. The environment team will set-up two areas for you to share your garden with our faith community. In front of each railing, we will have green plants set-up with a stand in the middle. We invite you to bring an arrangement or fresh cut flowers in vases to place on the stands each week. If you would like to share your summer bounty with us, please call the parish office 262-251-3944 or Bill at 262-251-2225 by the Thursday before each weekend so we can organize who is bringing in flowers. Flowers can be placed on the stands before the 4:30 pm Mass and taken back home after the 9:00 am Mass on Sunday or picked up later in the week.

Why fresh flowers? It seems like a lot of work.

The church asks us to use real plants and flowers in church environments. Like the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist, the authentic beauty of real flowers, plants etc. help us to experience the presence of God. Artificial plants and flowers may be practical and necessary sometimes, but they are only representations of natural beauty, not the beautiful flower, or plant itself created by God.

For many years I was a speaker for Sustaining the Mission (an Archdiocesan initiative to educate Catholic School teachers in matters of faith and theology). I would ask groups where they experienced God in their lives. Without fail the top three places were nature, personal relationships, and Church often in that order. What a gift Christ Jesus gave us in the Mass where all three of these things come together, helping us to recognize and receive God.

St. James Parish has an opening for a Financial Administrative Assistant. This position works in collaboration with and supports the Director of Administrative Services (DAS) in the daily aspects of financial reporting for the parish. Major responsibilities include processing weekly cash deposits and journal entries, weekly preparation of accounts payable checks, monthly reconciliation of bank and investment accounts and preparation of monthly financial reports for the DAS and Finance Council.

An associate or bachelor's degree in finance or accounting, along with prior bookkeeping or accounting experience, is preferred. Successful candidates will be self motivated, detail oriented and possess strong interpersonal skills. This position is non-exempt and may be part-time (24-28 hours per week) or full-time (30-32 hours per week). Full-time position includes benefits, with weekly hours not to exceed 32.
